#### PLANNING AND RESEARCH

- **Destination:** Beyond the attractions, study the culture, language, cuisine, traditions, and festivals of the place.
- Detailed Itinerary: Set the days, times, places to visit, and any tours. Use apps like Google Maps to optimize your routes.



#### **DOCUMENTS**

- Passport: Check the expiration date. Many countries require that your passport be valid for at least six months after the travel date.
- Visas: Find if your destination requires a visa and the steps to obt if your destination requires a visa and the steps to obtain it.ain it.
- **Travel Insurance**: Consider purchasing insurance that covers medical emergencies, flight cancellations, lost luggage, etc.



#### HEALTH

## MONEY

#### LUGGAGE

- Suitcase: Choose a sturdy suitcase of appropriate size for the duration of your trip.
